Honda cadet drivers (P)

next to their race numbers have previously finished in the top five of an A-Final and are recognised as "Pros". Pro drivers are eligible to win trophies awarded to drivers placed 1st to 5th in the A-Final.

Honda cadet drivers (no P) also compete for Clubman trophies awarded to the first 5 non-Pro finishers in the A-Final.

Clubman drivers who finish in the top 5 overall will claim 2 trophies and be promoted to "Pro"; they will no longer be eligible to compete in the Clubman Class.

Trophies for other classes are awarded dependent on number of participants and position.
